

# *Tiger Arts Open Exhibition*

The Exhibition - Open Evening 11<sup>th</sup> June 2010 and then continues to 19<sup>th</sup> June 2010

Tiger Arts Open Exhibition is a collaboration between local businesses and the Tiger Arts Gallery celebrating the vibrant talent of the West Midlands art scene and allowing regional artists the chance to show their work at the Tiger Arts venue in Malvern Link.

We are offering artists living in the 3 counties the opportunity to enter a competition to have their work displayed in an exhibition at the Tiger Arts Gallery, to win one of the prizes and to receive publicity for their work. The 3 stages involved are;

- 1) Send in photographs of your work for consideration
- 2) Judges choose which work goes into the exhibition
- 3) If selected to exhibit you bring your work to the gallery

## Who is eligible?

Tiger Arts Open welcomes submissions from artists living in the three counties (Worcestershire, Gloucestershire , Herefordshire )

## What kind of work is eligible?

Up to three works, created since January 2009 in the form of

- 2D (any medium)
- 3D (sculpture or construction)

## Prizes

- 1<sup>st</sup> prize £100
- 2<sup>nd</sup> prize £50
- 3<sup>rd</sup> prize £25

## How to enter

1) Images of the work(s) clearly marked with their title, submitted in the form of:

- JPG's on CD (300 dpi, minimum 14cm wide)
- Photographs
- N.B. Emailed images not accepted

2) Entry fee

# *Tiger Arts Open 2010*

## Conditions of entry

- Furniture, craft and applied art are not eligible
- 2D must not exceed 2m maximum in any direction, including frame
- 3D work must not require more than one person to carry it, and must not exceed 25kg in weight
- The organiser reserves the right to exclude at any stage work that poses any health and safety risk, or is deemed inappropriate in content
- By entering your submission to Tiger Arts Open you are agreeing that Tiger Arts Gallery can use your images and information in public material
- All work must be offered for sale
- All applicants must be 16 and over

## Selection

- Selection will be made by independent judges after the closing date (14<sup>th</sup> May 2010) The judges' decision is final
- Successful applicants will be informed of the decision by the 28<sup>th</sup> May 2010

## Selected work

- Selected work must be delivered to Tiger Arts no later than the 7<sup>th</sup> of June 2010
- All 2D work must be strung and ready to hang. No mirror mounts or clip frames will be permitted; work submitted in clip frames will be rejected
- All work must be clearly labelled with artist's name, address, title of work, direction of image (e.g. this way up), sale price (this is the purchase price off which commission will be deducted)
- You will be informed when a work is sold; buyers will pay Tiger Arts in full at the time of purchase and the artist will be paid 66% of the sale price at the end of the exhibition (19<sup>th</sup> June 2010)
- All works will remain on display until the end of the exhibition (19<sup>th</sup> June 2010)
- Unsold work to be collected by 21<sup>st</sup> June 2010

## Indemnity

- Tiger Arts will be responsible for loss or damage of work(s) whilst in the custody of Tiger Arts to a maximum value of £50.
- Tiger Arts does not take responsibility for loss or damage of work(s) in transit to or from the gallery
