1. The standard commission rate for work sold through the gallery is 33%. However the gallery reserve the right to vary this slightly where amounts are not in full pounds when paying commission.
2. The gallery has public liability insurance and insurance against theft or damage of goods but this is limited to £50 per item. Also it is worth noting that the perceived value of work prior to sale is the materials alone. The gallery will endeavour to look after all pieces in its care appropriately. However if you believe the value to be far greater than our insurance limitations then you will need to make your own arrangements regarding cover.
3. The gallery will require a stock list from each artist. This should be in the form of a printed list handed to a member of gallery staff when dropping off work. The information should include a name or ID no for each piece, the materials which the item is made from and a price. The price can either be the “on the wall” price or the “after commission” price, whichever is easier for you to calculate. Please make sure this is clear on your information.
4. The artist and gallery will agree a period when their work shall be displayed and during which commission from any sales is due to the gallery. Artists are responsible for collecting their work on an agreed date after display.
5. The gallery will provide display equipment or hanging space but it would be helpful if you have considered how your work will be displayed and made allowances for your work being in a public space. For example if your painting is not strung then it may not be hung. If you choose to leave display equipment of some description to aid the display of your work the gallery will use it where appropriate and return it in the condition it was left.
6. Remember our prices do not include VAT as we are not registered for VAT.
7. Please remember that a customer does have statutory rights and may in certain circumstances return work after it has been purchased. The gallery will work to manage these issues when they arise but do ask for you to flexible if this issue occurs.
8. If at any point you are not happy with the way the gallery is operating in relation to these terms then please speak to us. We will contact you if we feel we are missing something or are in need of further information.
9. Finally please remember that the gallery is a not for profit social enterprise set up to provide a venue for the visual arts. We will endeavour to display your work as professionally as possible and deal with the public to promote and where appropriate sell your work. Please work with us to ensure everyone achieves their desired outcome.
10. In addition to the normal terms and conditions when an artist or group of artists is using the gallery for a dedicated exhibition then a charge of £250 is raised for the use of the venue. This charge is payable after the exhibition has ended and can be offset against commission owed to the artist.
